## ON IPAD

### How can you open the EPUB?

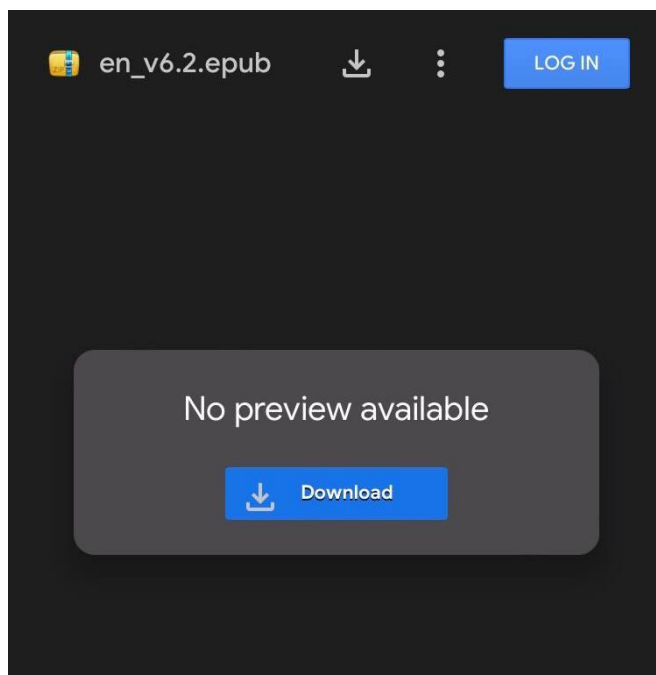
- With the *Books* application (which is already installed on your devices)

### What IOS version is required?

iOS 10.0 or later

### How to download the EPUBs


- Double click on the file
- This message appears on the screen:

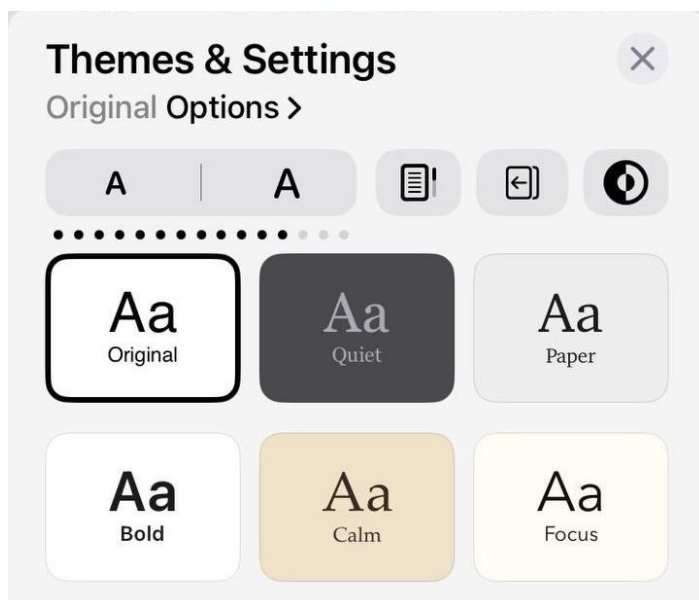


- Click on “Download”
- Another Page Opens, asking whether you want to download the file
- Again, click on “Download”
- You can find the file in the download folder on your iPad. You may copy it to a personal folder if you wish.
- To open the book, simply click on it. It opens the book in your “Books” app.

## iPad settings

### Adjust text size

- With the book open, click on the lower half of your screen.
- Click on this icon: 
- Themes and settings
- Click on the large "A" to increase the text size until you can read the text comfortably:



### Important

To make these eBooks, features were created that can sometimes interfere with certain reader settings.

So the theme should ALWAYS remain Original.



It is best to close the EPUBs after reading.

Otherwise, EPUB3 may display all the levels at the same time. If this happens to you, don't panic: close the book and reopen it, and everything will be back to normal.



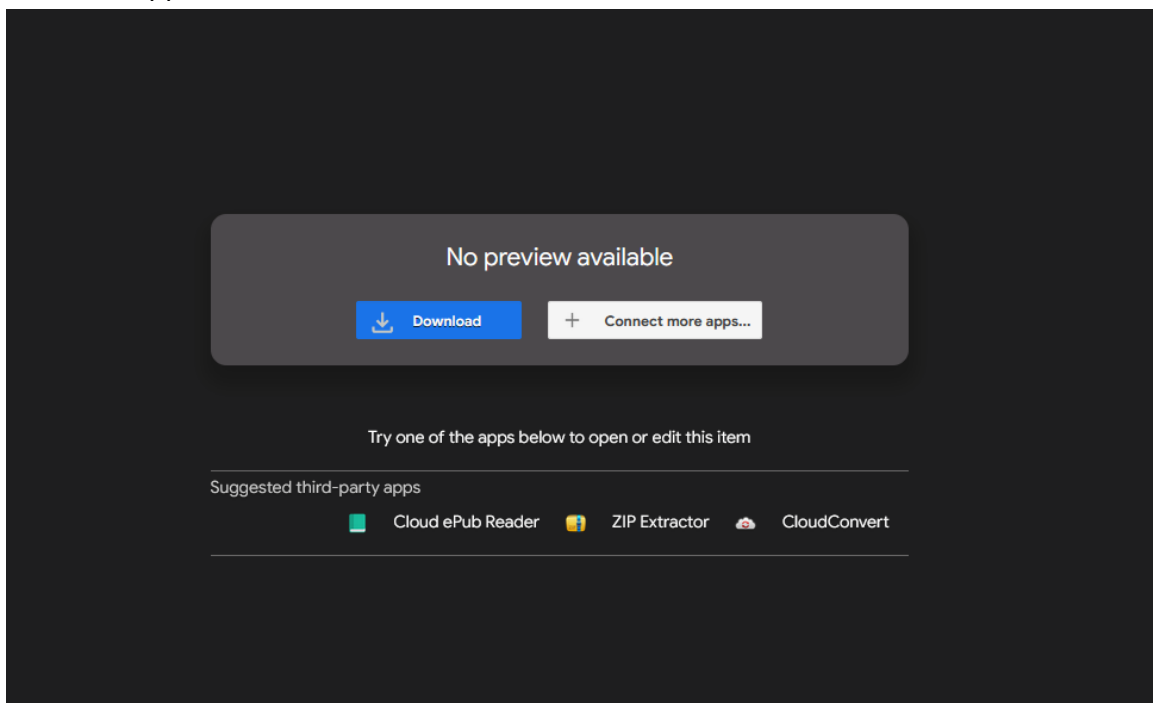
# ON COMPUTER

## With what software can I open the EPUBs?

- Thorium for PC or MAC
- **Download [HERE](#).** (updated 04/04/2024)  
(click on download and choose the version for your operating system).  
This application is designed for accessibility and can read EPUB3s.
- If you have Mac, you can use the application “Books” which is installed by default

## How to download the EPUB

- Double click on the file
- Then this appears on the screen:



- Click on *Download*
- The download should start automatically
- You can find the file in your computer's download folder. You can copy it to a different folder if you wish.
- To open the book, simply double-click on it.
- You can also drag it into Thorium if you prefer.

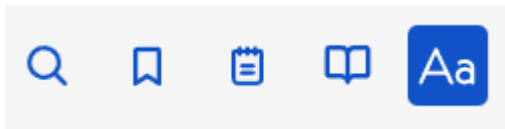


## Thorium settings

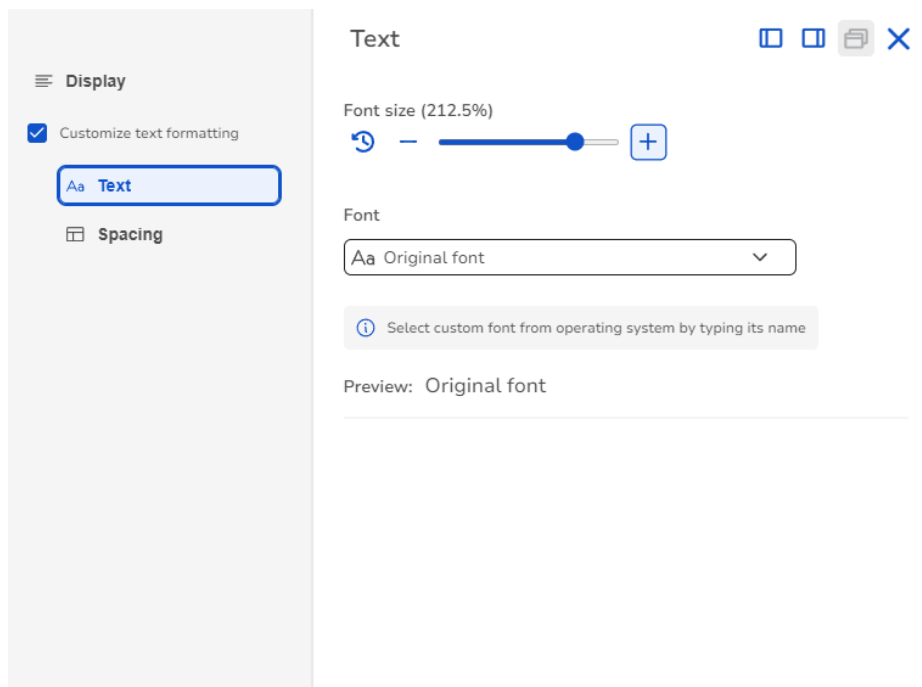
### Increase text size

You can increase the text size as much as you like.

To do this, click on the menu on the top right that says "Aa":



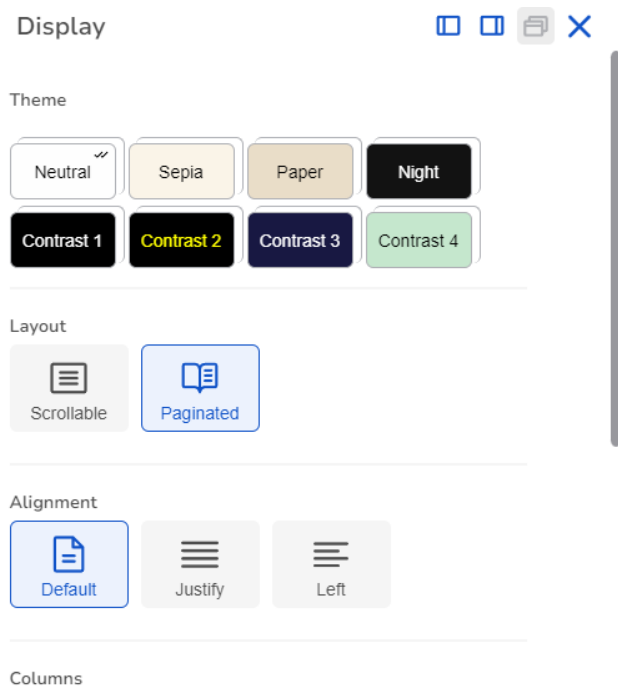
Go to "Text" and move the cursor to the right to increase it, or press on the "+":



### Settings that shouldn't be changed

To make these eBooks, features were created that can sometimes interfere with certain reader settings.

**The theme should ALWAYS remain neutral.**



## Settings on Books (mac)

### Landscape mode

When you switch to landscape mode, the application (depending on the iOS version) may display 2 pages at once. To avoid this, you need to increase the font size to a certain (very large) size.

### Settings not to be touched

As with Thorium, leave the theme untouched and do not use the "Vertical scrolling" option.

### Common problems

If you encounter a bug (page not turning, font not displaying properly, etc.) return to the library and click on the book.

To download EPUB3

- Click on the file
- It loads automatically and opens directly with Reasily.

Settings on Reasily

For ease of navigation, we recommend the "change page with volume buttons" option.

To do this:

- Click on the 3 dots at the top right of the screen.
- Go to "Reading mode"
- Click on "Use volume keys to turn pages".

## Basic Usage

### Book list

- Click the + button at the bottom right of the screen.
- If you put your books in your library, click the hamburger menu icon (☰) at the top left of the screen. Upgrade to Pro to add multiple categories.
- Able to send selected EPUB files to your email.
- You can also send EPUB files to your printer.
- Menu option to store imported files in SD card.
- Pin selected books to top.
- Add shortcut of the selected book to home screen.
- Sort books by recent accessed, author, publish date or folder.
- Book categorization by adding labels to selected books.

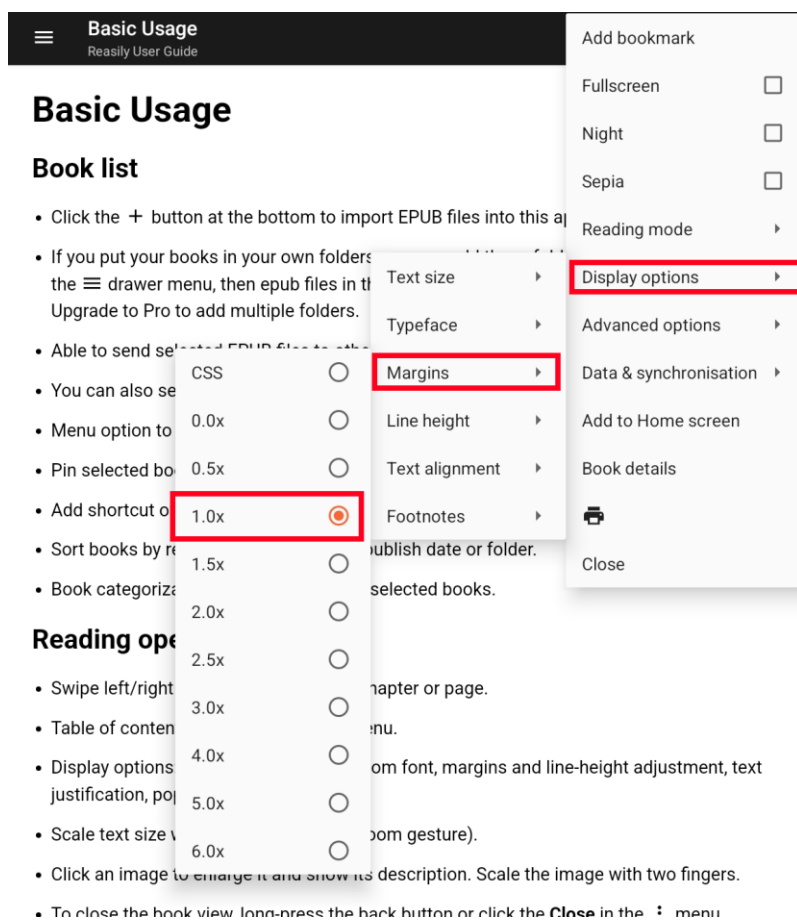

Otherwise, it is possible to navigate by clicking on the right and left of the screen, but on the left this sometimes launches the EPUB3 menu without you being able to do anything about it.

For ease of display, we recommend 1.0x margins.



To do this, go to Display Options / Margins and tick 1.0x.
